Sponsorship Opportunities

TGCSA has five regular meetings each year: January, March, April/May, June, August. Additionally, the annual meeting is held in November. The annual fund-raiser, the TGCSA Scholarship Tournament and Auction, the biggest event each year, is held in the fall. All dates are subject to change due to availability of host course.

Hole Sponsorships

At all meetings hole sponsorships are available for \$50 per hole. These are used for closest to the hole on the par 3 holes, longest drive, longest putt, etc. depending on how many sponsors there are for a meeting. Hole sponsorship money is paid out in prizes. The purpose of hole sponsors is to add more fun to the golf game. Sponsors are recognized at the meeting, on the website and in the newsletter.

Meeting Sponsorships

Sponsorships are available for \$300 minimum at each of our six regular meetings. We also welcome meal sponsors, breakfast, or lunch. This can be instead of a meeting sponsor or in addition to. It can be for the total cost of the meal or a set amount over \$300. The sponsor, if they desire, can have a few minutes to talk about their company or themselves, but it is not the time for a lengthy sales pitch. They can also share handouts or give a-ways of various sorts. The sponsor receives recognition at the meeting, in the newsletter and on the website as a sponsor and supporter of TGCSA.

Other Sponsorships

Sponsorship opportunities are available at the Scholarship Tournament fund-raiser such as, drink sponsors, meal sponsors (lunch or dinner), or any amount towards a general sponsorship of the event, that you would like to contribute, is welcome and appreciated. At each of our regular meetings (excluding the Annual meeting), time is allotted for an educational session. The meeting sponsor is given the opportunity to provide the education, but they are not required to. Otherwise, the Chapter Executive Secretary will line up the education. Whenever possible, it is preferred to have education for one hour that qualifies to be approved for GCSAA educational points, but this is not required. The content of the education can be anything of interest to the superintendent's profession.
