### ***Sponsorship Opportunities***

TGCSA has five regular meetings each year: January, March, May or June, July or August, October. Additionally, the annual meeting is held in November. The annual fund-raiser, The TGCSA Scholarship Tournament and Auction, the biggest event each year, is projected to be held in the fall. All dates are subject to change due to availability of host course.

#### **Hole Sponsorships**

At all meetings hole sponsorships are available for \$50 per hole. These are used for closest to the hole for the par 3 holes, longest drive, longest putt, etc. depending on how many sponsors there are for a meeting. All hole sponsorship money is paid out in prizes. The purpose of hole sponsors is to add more fun to the golf game.

#### **Meeting Sponsorships**

At the five regular meetings, meeting sponsorships are available for \$300. Occasionally, the annual meeting is sponsored as well. The sponsor, if they desire to, can have a few minutes to talk about their company or themselves, but it is not the time for a lengthy sales pitch. They can also share handouts or give a-ways of various sorts, if they like. The sponsor receives recognition at the meeting, in the newsletter and on the website as a sponsor and supporter of TGCSA.

#### **Other Sponsorships**

Other sponsorship opportunities are available at Vendors Day such as, drink sponsors, meal sponsors (lunch, hors d'oeuvres, breakfast), or anything else someone wants to contribute to. Any amount is welcome. Talk with the President or Chapter Executive Secretary for more details and to determine the sponsorship that best fits your budget.

#### **Education**

At each of the five regular meetings time is allotted for an educational session. The meeting sponsor is given the opportunity to provide the education, but they are not required to. Otherwise, the Chapter Executive Secretary will line up the education. Whenever possible, it is preferred to have education for one hour that qualifies to be approved for GCSAA educational points, but this is not required. The content of the education can be anything of interest to the superintendent's profession.
