- Principles, practices and methods used in maintenance of golf course grounds and facilities.
- Principles of golf course maintenance, turf management and agronomy principles and techniques.
- Operation, maintenance and repair standards for specialized golf course equipment and vehicles.
- Irrigation equipment, water management systems and sprinkler control devices.
- Proper use and storage of chemicals including OSHA Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for hazardous chemicals used in the workplace.
- Federal, state and City safety rules and regulations, occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- Environmentally responsible and resource-efficient turf and grounds maintenance techniques.

License and certification requirements: A Texas State Driver's License is required. Pesticide Applicator License from the Texas Department of Agriculture is also required; technical training in turf maintenance and irrigation management is preferred.
